**Annual Security Report:** The Clery Act requires the College to disseminate a public annual security report (ASR) to students and employees. The purpose of the annual security report is to provide campus crime statistics on certain crimes in specified geographic areas in addition to details of campus safety, Violence Against Woman Act (VAWA), Title IX, sex offender registration website, campus security, emergency response and other related materials. The statistics include a three-year comparison of crimes in on-campus property, non-campus property, and public property. The College does not offer on campus housing. A summary of the three-year crime statistic is included in the School Catalog provided to prospective students prior to enrollment.
